GOVERNANCE OF ORISSA IN ORIYA LANGUAGE

Suggestion for amendment in Orissa Official Language Act, 1954,
advanced by Subhas Chandra Pattanayak, Representative, Odia
Bhasa Sangram Samiti

It is suggested that following sections should be added to Orissa Official Language Act 1954 by amendment.

Addition of new Section

Section – 4 (1) The nomenclature of the **Orissa Official Language Act. 1954** will be **The Odisha Public Language Act 1954.**

(2) The State Government may make rules for carrying out all or any of the purpose of this Act or for due enforcement of any or all provisions of this Act or for enlarging the scope or purpose of this Act or for providing punishment for the violence of any provision of this Act.

Section – 5 : The words Orissa and Oriya, wherever used in this Act, shall be spelled, read and pronounced as Odisha and Odia respectively.

The Odisha Official (Public) Language Rules, 2015

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the Odisha Official (Public) Language Act, 1954 (Odisha Act 14 of 1954), the State Government hereby make the following Rules, Namely:

Short title and
Commencement

1. (i) These Rules may be called the Odisha Official (Public) Language Rules, 2015.
(ii) They shall come into force at once.

Field of
operation of Odia

2. Odia shall be used as the language for all Official and Public Purposes of the State of Odisha including its legislative, executive and judiciary wings and all corporate and private institutions situated in the State of Odisha.

Provided that persons in such wings and institutions not being permanent residents of Odisha, may communicate in English with an Odia rendering of it, through an interpreter or a translator in case of oral and written communication respectively.

Language in Public
Meetings

3. All public servants of the State or working in the State shall deliver their speeches in Public meetings and gathering held in Odisha in Odia.
Provided that such a person, if not a permanent resident of Odisha, may use an interpreter or translator to convert his speech into odia.

Signboards etc for
Public propagation

4. All signboards, hoardings, advertisements, posters, pamphlets and name plates in Odisha meant for public reading, public knowledge or public information shall be only in Odia, or in any other language along with Odia.

Deeds registered in
Odisha

5. All deeds intended to be registered under the Indian Registration Act and presented for registration in Odisha shall be in Odia, or in any other language with an Odia rendering of it, failing which, the registering authority shall not register the deed

Notification

6. The State Government shall publish in official gazette, notifications required under section 2 sub-section (2) and section 3, within two months from the date of coming into force of these Rules.

Evidence and
judgment in courts

7. All evidence shall be recorded and all orders and judgments shall be passed by Courts, Tribunals, Executive Magistrates, quasi-Judicial authorities and disciplinary authorities in Odisha shall be in Odia, or in English with an Odia rendering thereof, unless and express intention to the contrary appears in any Law or Rule passed or made by the competent authority in these matters.

8. The State Government shall establish in the State of Odisha an Odia Language University and an Odia Academy for the development of Odia Literature and Language, within 2 years from the date of coming in to force of these Rules.
9. For the violation of any of the provisions of the Act or these Rules, and individual in case of violation by himself or herself, the head of the institution in case of violation by the institution, the chief executive of a company, firm or corporation in case of violation by it, and the head of the department of the State Government in case of violation by the department, shall be responsible and punished.
10. For the violation of any provision of the Act or these Rules, the person responsible for it in his personal capacity shall be punished with a fine of Rs.2,000/- and a person responsible in his official capacity shall be punished with a fine of Rs.10,000/-.

Provided that for each subsequent violation, the amount of fine shall be double of that for the first violation.

11. (i) There shall be a Committee consisting of three members to be constituted by the Chief Secretary of Odisha, of which, the Principal Secretary in charge of the Department of Culture shall be the ex-office Chairman, a Judicial Officer of the State not below the rank of an Assistant Sessions Judge and an eminent linguist with distinct experience in administration in matters concerning Odia Language, or an eminent teacher in Odia not below the rank of a Professor of any University of Odisha shall be the members. The Committee shall be named as the Language Committee, Odisha.
- (ii) The Committee shall, on the complaint of any person or institution, or SUO Motu, take up matters of violation of the provisions of the Act or these Rules for adjudication and decide the same by a majority of opinion, keeping in view the principles of natural justice.
- (iii) The Committee shall decide its own procedure.
- (iv) On the finding of violation of the provisions of the Act and these Rules, the Committee shall, by order, levy fine on the person responsible and direct the fine to be deposited into the Language Fund to be constituted by the Department of Culture.
- (v) The Language Fund shall be constituted by a initial grant of Rs.1 Crore by the Department of Culture and shall increase by subsequent grants by the same Departments and by the fines collected. The fund shall be utilized for the purpose of the Odia University and the Odia Academy referred to in Rule 8 above.
- (vi) The sitting of the Language Committee shall be held in the Department of Culture in the Odisha Secretariat. The Committee shall sit at least once in a month.
- (vii) Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Language Committee may within one month of such decision, prefer an appeal to the Session Judge, Khordha at Bhubaneswar. The judgment in appeal shall be final.
- (viii) The proceedings before the Language Committee and the Sessions Judge shall be disposed of, as far as practicable, within 6 months and 3 months respectively.
- (ix) The Department of Culture shall bear all expenses of and on the Language Committee and may decide and grant sitting allowances to the members of the Language Committee.
